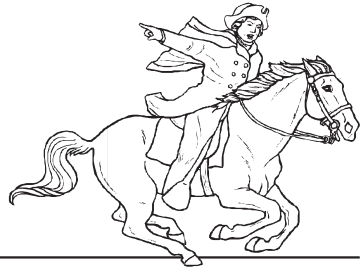

Calvert Hall Water Polo team to swim 100 mile relay

TOWSON, MD - Calvert Hall's Water Polo team, coached by Don Anderson, a 1968 graduate of The Hall, will swim a 100 mile continuous relay in Calvert Hall's Hucht Pool starting at 12pm on Friday, August 19, 2005.

Each swimmer will swim 1650 yards (approximately 1 mile) with the younger swimmers forming relay teams to complete the 1650 yards. The relay will continue until the entire team swims a combined total of 100 miles. The event should take about 40 hours of continuous swimming and will involve 20 swimmers.

The relay will not only condition the swimmers, but proceeds from the event will help pay for a new Colorado timing system at the school's pool as well as a donation to the St. Vincent's Center for Abused Children. Senior Zack Anderson, the captain of Calvert Hall's Swimming team, is a volunteer at St. Vincent's.

Recipes To Share With Your Neighbors

Feather-Light Fudge Brownies

1 1/2 cup sugar
1/2 cup egg or egg substitute
1/4 cup margarine, melted
2 tablespoons water
1 teaspoon vanilla extract
1/14 cups sifted cake flour
1/2 cup cocoa
1 teaspoon baking powder
Dash of salt
3/4 cup semisweet chocolate morsels
Vegetable cooking spray

Combine first 5 ingredients in a large bowl, stirring well. Combine flour, cocoa, baking powder, and salt; add to sugar mixture, stirring well. Stir in chocolate morsels.

Spoon batter into a 9-inch square pan coated with cooking spray. Bake at 325 degrees for 30 minutes. Cool on a wire rack and cut into squares. Yield: 16 brownies
